Aronia m. Low Scape Hedger®
Low Scape Hedger® Chokecherry

A narrow columnar selection that's perfect for creating hedges or mass plantings. Lower maintenance and faster to produce than 'Viking.'

White flowers in spring appear among dark glossy green foliage.

Brilliant fall color.

Hx\$ 4'x3'

Zones 3 to 9



Buxus jap. Green Beauty
Green Beauty Japanese Boxwood

A naturally rounded boxwood variety with excellent resistance to boxwood blight. Green, glossy foliage year round with slight winter bronzing in cold climates. More heat and drought tolerant than other varieties.

Hx\$ 5'x5'

Zones 6 to 9



Buxus m. Sprinter®
Sprinter® Boxwood

Named for its rapid growth rate, this improved variety of 'Winter Gem' is resistant to boxwood blight. Upright habit is great for low hedging or foundation plantings.

Hx\$ 4'x4'

Zones 5 to 9



Buxus s. Arctic Emerald
Arctic Emerald Boxwood

This amazing hybrid of Buxus sempervirens maintains deep green color all winter long with no bronzing. Tolerant of wind, ice, and snow. Grows in a dense, upright, somewhat pyramidal habit.

Hx\$ 7'x3'

Zones 4 to 9



Carpinus b. Lucas
Lucas Pyramidal Hornbeam

Lucas' extremely narrow, dense columnar shape is cloaked in dark green foliage into fall, when it turns brown but remains on the tree until new foliage appears in spring. Perfect for a tall hedge or as a pair flanking an entrance.

Hx\$ 30'x10'

Zones 4 to 9



Cercis c. Alley Cat
Alley Cat Eastern Redbud

Literally discovered in an alley, this cercis variety is no unwanted stray. Green foliage splashed with white makes this tree a striking addition to any landscape. Pink blooms blanket stems and branches in spring before foliage emerges.

Hx\$ 25'x30'

Zones 4 to 9



**Cercis c. Flame Thrower®
Flame Thrower® Redbud**

Another remarkable cercis variety, Flame Thrower foliage emerges burgundy and matures through yellow, finally to green. Multiple stages often on the same branch, creating a color show. Best color appears when planted in full sun.

Hx\$ 20'x15' Zones 5 to 9



**Cercis c. Golden Falls®
Golden Falls® Redbud**

Unique, diminutive variety of Redbud has a narrow, weeping form perfect for smaller spaces. Tiny pink flowers cloak stems and branches before chartreuse green foliage emerges. Color is strong all season long with no scorching.

Hx\$ 10'x3' Zones 5 to 9



**Cercis c. Pink Pom Pom®
Pink Pom Pom® Eastern Redbud**

This brand new cultivar is perfect for smaller yards, growing just 10' tall. Produces no messy seed pods. Fat pink double blooms cover branches in spring, followed by green glossy foliage that reflects sunlight.

**Cornus k. Scarlet Fire
Scarlet Fire Dogwood**

Large 8" blooms emerge creamy white in early spring and mature through the season to a deep burgundy red by fall. This cold hardy hydrangea thrives in full sun or partial shade.

**Ficus c. Chicago Hardy
Chicago Hardy Fig**

One of the hardiest fig varieties, Chicago Hardy thrives in zone 6 and above, but can tolerate zone 5 with protection. Ideal for a small accent tree, shrub, or a pot specimen. Produces delicious purplish brown figs in late summer.

**Hibiscus s. Orchid Satin®
Orchid Satin® Rose of Sharon**

Seedless and non-invasive, the graceful branches of this new variety make it a very appealing addition to a mixed border. Exceptionally large pink single blooms are accented by a dramatic red eye.

Hx\$ 10'x8' Zones 5 to 9



Hydrangea p. Fire & Ice
Fire & Ice Hydrangea

Large 8" blooms emerge creamy white in early spring and mature through the season to a deep burgundy red by fall. This cold hardy hydrangea thrives in full sun or partial shade.

Hx\$ 5'x4'

Zones 3 to 8



Hydrangea p. Bobo®
Bobo® Hydrangea

Exceptionally floriferous, this compact panicle hydrangea is smothered with large, lacy, white cones in summer that age to a lovely soft pink.

Hx\$ 3'x3'

Zones 3 to 8



Hydrangea p. Little Quick Fire®
Little Quick Fire® Hydrangea

Same early bloom time as the original Quick Fire®, but this dwarf cultivar is about one third the size. The compact habit makes it a great choice for extending the season in smaller landscapes and container gardens.

Hx\$ 4'x4'

Zones 3 to 8



Hydrangea p. Phantom
Phantom Panicle Hydrangea

A truly exceptional hydrangea, Phantom has enormous flower heads, up to 15" long on sturdy stems that won't flop over. Blooms emerge creamy white in midsummer and mature to soft pink. Fast grower.

Hx\$ 8'x8'

Zones 4 to 8



Hydrangea q. Ruby Slippers
Ruby Slippers Oakleaf Hydrangea

An amazing compact hydrangea with distinctive oakleaf foliage that stays deep green all season long, then turns mahogany in fall. Upright, hardy blooms won't droop or flop, even after heavy rains.

Hx\$ 3'x4'

Zones 5 to 9



Juniperus ch. Perfecta
Perfecta Juniper

Upright and narrow, Perfecta has bright green foliage that remains attractive year round. Relatively fast growing, perfect for screening or hedges. Drought tolerant.

Hx\$ 16'x7'

Zones 4 to 8



**Juniperus s. Blue Arrow
Blue Arrow Juniper**

Brilliant, bright blue foliage and a very narrow, upright form make the Blue Arrow another excellent choice for screening where space is limited. Silvery blue berries adorn the plant from spring to winter. Moderately fast grower.

Hx\$ 15'x2' Zones 4 to 9



**Juniperus s. Medora
Medora Juniper**

The naturally columnar, narrow form of Medora needs no pruning to maintain its shape. Hardy and tolerant of cold, heat, and coastal exposure.

Hx\$ 12'x3' Zones 3 to 7



**Magnolia g. Bracken's
Brown Beauty**

Bracken's Brown Beauty Magnolia

Hardier than other magnolia with excellent cold tolerance. Leathery, bicolor foliage is deep green on top and rich brown underneath. Very large (6"), fragrant white flowers in spring.

Hx\$ 25'x20' Zones 6 to 9



**Malus Firestorm™ Honeycrisp
Firestorm™ Honeycrisp Apple**

A red strain of Honeycrisp, Firestorm has all the delicious flavor and crunch of the original but with improved red color. Fruit stores well for up to 6 months.

Hx\$ 15'x15' Zones 4 to 9



**Populus t. Erecta
Columnar Swedish Aspen**

The same pleasing wind rustle sounds but on an upright, narrow form. Green foliage takes on amazing fall color. Thrives in cold climates; a great choice for Northern landscapes.

Hx\$ 40'x10' Zones 2 to 5



**Quercus x Long
Regal Prince® Oak**

A medium sized tree with a columnar growth habit. Leaves are dark green with silvery undersides. Creamy yellow catkins appear in spring. An excellent specimen in a large garden.

Hx\$ 60'x25' Zones 4 to 8

Hardy, disease resistant, and low maintenance; Drift® Roses provide all of the beauty without the headache. No need for spraying or deadheading. Trained into our signature tier and standard forms, these gorgeous flowers bloom profusely from late spring into autumn.





Syringa r. Ivory Silk
Ivory Silk Japanese Tree Lilac

Remains relatively compact as trees go, reaching only about 25 feet at maturity. Produces panicles of creamy white blooms with a different scent than the traditional lilac. Attractive reddish bark brings visual interest all year long.

Hx\$ 25'x15' Zones 3 to 7



Thuja o. Holmstrup
Holmstrup Eastern Arborvitae

A smaller version of 'Emerald Green', Holmstrup is more columnar with compact branching. Retains deep green color well through cold winters. Relatively slow growing.

Hx\$ 15'x4' Zones 3 to 7



Thuja o. Tater Tot®
Tater Tot® Arborvitae

Naturally grows as a tidy little globe of fragrant, fan-like evergreen foliage. It's tolerant of shade too, so you can plant it just about anywhere and enjoy year-round beauty from this easy care native shrub.

Hx\$ 2'x2' Zones 3 to 7



Thuja p. Forever Goldy
Forever Goldy Arborvitae

Bright golden color provides a color pop in the landscape year round, hence the name 'Forever Goldy'. Won't sunburn or fade.

Hx\$ 12'x3' Zones 5 to 8



Thuja p. Sugar & Spice
Sugar & Spice Western Cedar

Narrow-growing, upright thuja well suited for small spaces. Very fine textured, green to cream-green foliage on orange-brown stems. Heat tolerant.

Hx\$ 10'x3' Zones 5 to 8



Vaccinium c. Pink Popcorn™
Pink Popcorn™ Highbush Blueberry

Medium sized, very hardy blueberry produces an abundance of large, pinkish-cream berries. Will self-pollinate, but a larger yield results from planting close to another mid-season variety.

Hx\$ 4'x4' Zones 3 to 8
